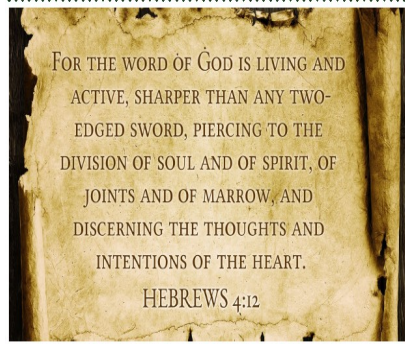




Transforming Bible Studies
